Birdwatchers:

We had a great bird presentation by the folks from "The Birdwatchers store," in Slippery Rock at Been There Done That last month. The presentation caused me to think about the birds of the Bible. Birds were created on the 5th day, Genesis 1:20-21. Then in Genesis 8:9-11, Noah sent a dove to discover dry land. It returned to him the first time without finding dry land. But the second time it returned with an olive leaf in its beak. The dove represents life, the Holy Spirit and a new beginning in Christ. In I Kings 17:6, the ravens bring the prophet Elijah bread and flesh in the morning and bread and flesh in the evening. The raven represents God's provision in times of challenge and change. God is able to meet all our needs no matter how difficult the situation may be. Ravens also represent obedience to the commands of God. If birds are wise enough to obey God, we should do likewise. In Matthew 6, Jesus used birds to emphasize God's loving care of us, therefore we don't need to worry. In Matthew 10:29-31, Jesus says, "Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? Yet not one of them will fall to the ground outside your Father's care...So don't be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows." The sparrow represents our great worth to God.
